
HALL OF FAME INDUCTEE

ALANA NICHOLS

Originally from Farmington, New Mexico, Nichols is a world-class athlete with a passion for challenging herself and others. From a young age, her passion for sports and adventure has driven her, and no matter what obstacle life throws her way, she takes a challenge head-on. After suffering a spinal cord injury at age 17 while attempting a back flip on her snowboard, Alana quickly transitioned to adaptive sports. She is the first American female to win gold medals at both the Summer (Wheelchair Basketball) and Winter (Alpine Ski Racing) Olympic/Paralympic Games.


Nichols's impressive career includes a 2008 gold medal from the Paralympic Summer Games in basketball, two gold medals in downhill and giant slalom, a silver medal in the Super G, and a bronze medal in the Super Combined at the 2010 Paralympic Winter Games. She continued her success as a 2011 NWBA National Champion, a 2011 Colorado Sports Woman of the Year Recognition, the 2011 Paralympic Athlete of the Year, the 2011 World Champion in the Downhill Super G, and the 2014 silver medalist in the downhill at the Paralympic games in Sochi, Russia. In May 2014, Nichols was inducted into the Warner Brothers "Superman Hall of Heroes" in the inaugural class of real-life heroes.




FREDD YOUNG


Fredd Young is a 1984 graduate of New Mexico State University, Young was a 1981, 1982 & 1983 First Team All-Missouri Valley Conference member, a 1983 Associated Press Honorable Mention All-American Team, and a 1983 Sporting News Honorable Mention All-American team member while amassing 400 tackles during his four-year career at NMSU. These statistics led him to be inducted into the NMSU Hall of Fame in 1991 and the Aggie Legend Ring of Honor in 2007.

Young was drafted in the 3rd round of the 1984 NFL draft with the 76th overall pick. Young made his name for himself as a special teams player early in his NFL career, making the NFL Pro Bowl in 1984 and 1985 as a special teamer. He continued his impressive career with consecutive Pro Bowls in 1986 and 1987 as a linebacker. Young finished his career with the Indianapolis Colts, amassing 601 tackles, 21 quarterback sacks, and three interceptions.

Young was recognized after his career concluded by the Seahawks by being named to the 2010 35th anniversary team, and in 2016 was honored as one of the Top 40 players of all time in Seahawks history.



"Your belief in my contributions to the world of sports means more than words can fully capture. I also want to thank my NMSU Aggies, Seattle Seahawks, and Indianapolis Colts family. Also, my mom, rest her soul, for all her unwavering support throughout my journey. Without her, this Sports moment would not have been possible. Every achievement in my career resulted from countless hours of hard work, sacrifice, and dedication."





ENMU WOULD LIKE TO SAY CONGRAIS TO OUR ALUMNI





MICHAEL SINCLAIR

Sinclair, originally from Galveston, Texas, came to ENMU and became an All-Lone Star Conference All-Decade Player, earning consecutive first-team All-LSC selections in 1989 and 1990 and was named the LSC defensive lineman of the year as a senior in 1990 as well as being named to the 1990 Associated Press Little All-American team for Division II. He concluded his ENMU career with 279 tackles, 45 tackles for a loss, and 30 sacks.

Drafted in the sixth round of the 1991 NFL Draft, Sinclair went on to a stellar career with the Seattle Seahawks and Philadelphia Eagles, registering 353 tackles, 73.5 QB sacks, nine fumble recoveries, and two touchdowns over his 11-year NFL career.

Sinclair's distinguished career with the Seahawks included being named as an NFL Pro-Bowler three times; his 73.5 career sack total ranks second all-time in Seahawks history, and Sinclair has the most sacks of anyone in the entire 1991 draft class.

After his career, Sinclair has had several recognitions, including being elected to the ENMU Hall of Honors, being named to the Seahawks all-time GOAT team, being ranked as one of the Seahawk's top ten defensive players of all-time, and being named to the Seahawks all-time team.

"I sincerely appreciate and am incredibly thankful for the chance to be called one of many great athletes who contributed to the state of New Mexico's sports landscape," said New Mexico Sports Hall of Famer Michael Sinclair. "I would like to thank Coach Carthel and his staff for helping me mature into a responsible young man and a good football player. I'm also grateful to my teammates, who helped me see that it's more about the journey than the destination. Being selected into this pool of greatness is awesome, but also a responsible mantle of representing my family, ENMU, and my professional endeavors."



ROY COOPER

The late Hobbs New Mexico native, is a former American professional rodeo cowboy who competed in Professional Rodeo Cowboys Association (PRCA) events for over two decades.


Inducted into the Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame in Colorado Springs, Colorado, in 1979, Cooper was part of the Hall's inaugural class enshrined in the category of Tie-Down Roping. For his skills in calf roping, he acquired the nickname "Super Looper". The Pro Rodeo Hall of Fame calls Cooper "one of the most dominant ropers in the sport's history."

Cooper won the 1976 PRCA Rookie of the Year, the 1976 and 1980-84 PRCA calf roping world championship, the 1983 PRCA steer roping world championship, the 1983 PRCA all-around

world championship and the 1992 PRCA Texas Circuit calf roping championship.

Cooper is a 1979 Pro Rodeo Hall of Famer, a 1983 Rodeo Hall of Famer of the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum, a 2008 Texas Rodeo Hall of Famer, a 2009 Lea County Sports Hall of Famer, and a 2014 Oklahoma Sports Hall of Famer.

Sadly, Roy passed away in the spring of 2025. The New Mexico Sports Hall of Fame salutes the "Super Looper."



STEVE LOY

Loy, a 1970 Sandia High School Graduate, was a two-year letterman on the football team, a 1969 NM Associated Press Honorable Mention all-state defensive back, and a 1969 Albuquerque Tribune First Team All-City Defensive Back. Loy also was the state runner-up in golf in 1969.

Loy came to Eastern New Mexico University in 1970 as a member of the football and golf teams. At ENMU, Loy was the team captain for the 1972 and 1973 Greyhound football teams, was an intercollegiate all-American in golf, and graduated from ENMU in 1974.

After college, Loy began a successful career as a collegiate golf coach and athletic administrator. Loy started his career at Scottsdale Community College as the head golf coach and a professor. He continued his career as an associate athletic director and head golf coach at the University of Arkansas and finally moved to Arizona State University as their head golf coach. Since 1992, he has served as the president of Gaylord Sports Management, Lagardere Unlimited, and SportFive (presently the largest golf sports agency in the world, operating in 41 countries on five continents).

As a college golf coach, Loy was a three-time national coach of the year, coached three NCAA National Championship Teams, and his 1990 Arizona State University Men's and Women's teams were the only teams to win the National Championships together in the same year.

When Loy moved into his management career, he owned and operated multiple golf properties throughout Arizona and is an avid investor in several businesses. He has coached or managed over 40 All-Americans, eight Ryder Cup players, seven national champions, four US Amateur champions, and two number-one professional golfers worldwide, including Hall of Famers Phil Mickelson and Davis Love. Additionally, Loy has represented some of the game's superstars, including Phil Mickelson, Jon Rahm, and Davis Love, among others.

Loy has been inducted into several halls of fame over the course of his career, including the ENMU Athletics Hall of Honor, Scottsdale Community College Hall of Fame, NJCAA Coaches Hall of Fame, NCAA Coaches Hall of Fame, Arizona State and University of Arkansas Hall of Fame, and the Sandia High School Hall of Fame.

"As a former student-athlete at Sandia High School and Eastern New Mexico University and a true New Mexican at heart, my family and I are truly honored to receive this recognition," said New Mexico Sports Hall of Famer Steve Loy.
